INSTRUCTIONS & INFO

Letter Overview:

Some but not all programs may require a letter of intent/statement of purpose. The information you provide will improve the program/department's understanding of your motivations, interests and skills that are not obvious from your grades alone.

Your letter should provide information on:

- 1. What are your short-term and long-term career goals?
- 2. How will the acquisition of this degree serve to advance you towards your professional goals?
- 3. The research area that you are interested in pursuing.
- 4. The prospective AU faculty mentor you would like to work with (and whether you have been in contact with them).
- 5. Outline and expand on any relevant research experiences you have.
- 6. Outline and expand where necessary any future career goals that would be specifically served by attending Auburn University.

Finally, while a Letter of Intent is an important instrument, it is still a personal statement of interest and can appropriately contain any information that the applicant feels is unique or important about their academic or research experience.

This document should be restricted to 1-2 pages and uploaded directly through the AU Graduate School's online application system.
