- The Graduate Council approved without opposition a revision and expansion of the **Second Master's Degree** policy to apply to any **Second Graduate or Post-Baccalaureate Professional Degree**. The text of the approve policy is shown below:

Second Graduate or Post-Baccalaureate Professional Degree

For a second graduate or post-baccalaureate professional degree, the student fulfills all requirements applicable to any other graduate or post-baccalaureate professional degree, including the thesis, if appropriate. The student may, on recommendation of the advisory committee, transfer a limited number of credit hours from the previous graduate or post-baccalaureate professional degree. At least 24 semester hours, or 50% of the total hours required for the degree, whichever is greater, must be unique to each degree and be taken at Auburn University.
